ADMINISTRATOR'S COLUMN

By now all registered parishioners should have gotten a copy of the Christmas mailing. If you didn't, please call the office so we can make sure you're on the list and get you a copy. As I mentioned in the letter, the printers ask for that letter in August because of how much time they need to print everything and get the volume mailed in time. Fun fact: we already got word a couple weeks ago that it's time to start thinking about the Easter mailing.

Likewise, we have deadlines for the parish bulletin as well. In any given parish, if something unexpected happens at the end of a week, it's not going to be reflected in that Sunday's bulletin, since the bulletin was probably finalized the previous Tuesday. At the end of the year, bulletin deadlines are even earlier than usual because of the holidays. Some weeks we're working on two bulletins at once, and the bulletin for some Sundays is done almost two weeks before you get it. (Side note: it's a time of year to be especially nice to parish secretaries and bulletin editors, because keeping up with all the deadlines and dates is enough to make your head spin.)

I write all of the above for a reason. In this time of pandemic, we are dealing with much uncertainty. Regulations and guidelines may change with barely a moment's notice. Schedules may be adjusted without notice. With such rapid change, information in our printed materials may be out-of-date before you even get it. So please be sure to visit our parish website and Facebook page regularly, because the most up-to-date information will be there. You do not need a Facebook account to view our page.

As I said a couple weeks ago, we also signed up with Flocknote so we can e-mail and text people important information. We're working on adding information we have for the parish, but you can help us. All you have to do is text STGABRIELSTOWE to 84576. You'll get a response with further instructions. Please note that message and data rates may apply if you do this. You can also sign up by going to stgabrielstowe.flocknote.com and adding your e-mail address and cell phone number. If you're not one for text messaging on a cell phone, you don't have to give a phone number.

One schedule change we can print here: **Starting January 1, the Daily Mass schedule is going to be adjusted.** Mass will now be celebrated Tuesday – Friday, with no Mass on Monday. Eucharistic Adoration will move to Wednesdays, at the same time. There are several reasons why I'm making this change, but I'm running out of space to explain everything here (and remember, we're trying to keep the secretary happy right now, so a column that's too long is a big no-no), but we did poll some of the usual Daily Mass crowd and those who come to Adoration regularly, and they were okay with the change.

Also, there will not be a Vigil Mass at 4pm on New Year's Eve. Mass will be celebrated on January 1 at 9am. The mailing indicated we would have a vigil.

Like I said, early deadlines. I'm not even sure which Sunday this is going to appear in print, so, uhh, Happy [blank] week of Advent!

READINGS FOR SUNDAY, DECEMBER 20

First Reading - 2 Samuel 7:1-5, 8b-12, 14a, 16

When King David was settled in his palace, and the Lord had given him rest from his enemies on every side, he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God dwells in a tent!" Nathan answered the king, "Go, do whatever you have in mind, for the Lord is with you." But that night the Lord spoke to Nathan and said: "Go, tell my servant David, 'Thus says the Lord: Should you build me a house to dwell in? "It was I who took you from the pasture and from the care of the flock to be commander of my people Israel. I have been with you wherever you went, and I have destroyed all your enemies before you. And I will make you famous like the great ones of the earth. I will fix a palace for my people Israel; I will plant them so that they may dwell in their place without further disturbance. Neither shall the wicked continue to afflict them as they did of old, since the time I first appointed judges over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also reveals to you that he will establish a house for you. And when your time comes and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your heir after you, sprung from your loins, and I will make his kingdom firm. Gospel - Luke 1:26-38

The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary. And coming to her, he said, "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you." But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. and you shall name him Jesus.
