Feast Day of Our Patron, Saint Gabriel of the Sorrowful Mother

Francis Possenti was born in Assisi on March 1, 1838, the eleventh of thirteen children. His mother died when he was four years old, and her death left a void in his heart. An older sister, Mary Louise, tried to take her place; but no one could really take the place of his mother. So Francis turned to the Mother of God and sought her protection and care. He confided all his cares to her. In temptations her name was always on his lips, and his burning love for her gave him sufficient courage in overcoming every obstacle.

Francis was like a teenager of today. He loved fancy clothes, was conscious of his appearance and was noted as a good dancer. He was fond of literature and the theater. However, in later years he felt a growing dissatisfaction within himself. It was as if Our Lord was calling him to a higher state in life. Indeed Our Lord was calling him – through His mother.

In 1856 a cholera epidemic swept over the city of Spoleto; and Francis's sister, Mary Louise, become its victim. After the epidemic, the Archbishop of Spoleto carried a painting of the Mother of God through the streets in a solemn procession of thanksgiving. As Francis knelt, it seemed as though the Madonna was looking directly at him. This was a sign for Francis – a sign not to put off giving his life for Christ.

He attended the Jesuit College of Spoleto. The day after his graduation, Francis was on his way to the novitiate at Morrovale, to enter one of the strictest congregations in the Church, the Passionists. The Passionist Congregation was founded in the eighteenth century by St. Paul of the Cross. Its purpose is to promote devotion to the life-giving Passion and Death of Christ.

Francis began his year of training as a novice by laying his secular dress and embracing the rough, black habit and sandals of a Passionist. At this ceremony he took the new name of Gabriel and the title of Our Lady's Sorrows. After his

year of novitiate he pronounced the vows of a religious.

Gabriel had repeated bouts with sickness, and later learned that he had tuberculosis. This did not weaken his spirits, and he longed for the day when he would celebrate his First Mass. After five years as a Passionist, on May 25, 1861, Gabriel received Minor Orders. He practiced the ceremonies of the Mass in preparation for his First Mass, but God had different plans in store for Gabriel.

Gabriel died on February 27, 1862. He was buried at the monastery at Isola. Many pilgrims visited his tomb and numerous miracles were attributed to him. Thus, forty-six years after his death, on May 31, 1908, Pope St. Pius X proclaimed Gabriel of the Sorrowful Virgin to be Blessed. Twelve years later, on May 13, 1920, Pope Benedict XV enrolled Gabriel among the saints of God. His feast day is February 27. He is the patron of youth, especially young religious.
