



St. Paul told the Corinthians "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." -1 Corinthians 11:26

"Both bread and wine are made by gathering the many and crushing them into a unified substance. Crushing many grains of wheat and molding them into one substance makes bread. Crushing grapes into juice and letting the juice age and ferment makes wine. The Church which is the Body of Christ, is made up of the "many" who are made one through the sacrifice of Christ.
