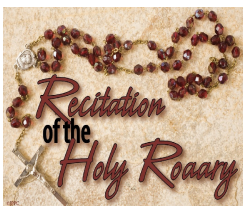
**ETERNAL REST** grant unto them, O Lord. May the souls of the faithful departed rest in peace, ANGELINA DE MARIO.
